Out of Hours School Care Child Safe Environment Policy

Policy Statement

All children attending the Out of School Hours Care (OSHC) program are provided with the opportunity to explore both indoors and outdoors. Supervision of children must always be a priority with challenging equipment and activities. All activities and experiences are to be provided in a safe and nurturing environment.

Procedures and Practices

- Children will be supervised as per the ratio outlined in the Education and Care Services Regulations 2011. Ratio 1:15 is always required. For every 30 children there needs to be one qualified staff member. (Refer to the staff arrangement policy)
- Staff will ensure that the grounds and equipment are in good working order and conduct regular inspections.
- Any broken equipment will be made inaccessible to children. Equipment will be replaced.
- Hazardous substances are inaccessible to children.
- OHSC follows Apollo Parkways PS COVID safe plan.
